

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPA ALGICIDE 10 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, use SPA ALGICIDE 10 to using SPA ALGICIDE 10.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of SPA ALGICIDE 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae growth in decorative fountains, hot tubs, and whirlpools, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of SPA ALGICIDE 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13 fluid ounces of SPA ALGICIDE 10 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and whirlpools with algae growth require an initial dose of 8 fluid ounces of SPA ALGICIDE 10 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 fluid ounce of SPA ALGICIDE 10 should be made once per month for maintenance.

SPA ALGICIDE 10 will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should be treated with 65 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. Season pools have some visible algae growth, add 76 fluid ounces of SPA ALGICIDE 10 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

SPA ALGICIDE 10 is compatible with chlorine and can be used with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix SPA ALGICIDE 10 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking container should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in plastic.
