


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Then have patient drink plenty of milk, gelatin solution, beaten egg whites, flour and water, or other nonoily demulcent. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

TWC Formula 3210 is used in industrial and cooling tower systems and industrial air-washing systems to clean. Prior to the use of TWC Formula 3210 in recirculating cooling tower systems, systems should be cleaned of microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then make an initial addition of 6.8 fl. oz. of TWC Formula 3210 per 40 to 60 ppm of Formula 3210 of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Add an additional 2.3 to 6.8 fl. oz. of TWC Formula 3210 per gal. of water to 20 to 60 ppm Formula 3210 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug the sump of recirculating cooling tower systems.

TWC Formula 3210 is used in industrial and cooling tower systems to maintain effective mist-eliminating components. Prior to the use of TWC Formula 3210 in industrial and cooling tower systems, systems should be cleaned to remove bacterial slime and other deposits. An initial addition of 13.6 fl. oz. of Formula 3210 per gal. of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent additions of 7.9 to 13.6 fl. oz. of Formula 3210 per gal. of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and severity of the microbiological problem. Additional additions may be made to the sump or the water collection system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not stack more than 10 drums should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use.
