CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Thoroughly mix TPC-RE-PEL with water at the appropriate dilution indicated below to form an emulsifiable liquid. Prepare fresh solution before each use. Apply mixture to horses with pressure sprayer or by sponge-on application. Make sure horses coat is thoroughly wet all over with the solution.

To protect horses from Hornflies, Houseflies, Gnats and Mosquitoes use 1 part TPC-RE-PEL to 7 parts of water. Repeat application every 3 or 4 days or as often as needed. Avoid getting solution in animals eyes.

For Horse flies (Tabanids) or Stable flies apply at a rate of 1 part TPC-RE-PEL to 4 parts of water and repeat applications as often as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal (Plastic): Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
