For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 4 fluid ounces of SWIMPOL KLEAN - 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. To move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of SWIMPOL KLEAN - 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of Swimpol Klean - C per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Swimpol Klean - C per 10,000 gallons of water.
