 - d. A statement recommending when the unit should be backflushed should be included on the leaflet.
 - e. If you wish, you may include a diagram of the installation procedure on the leaflet.


The manufacturing procedure is acceptable.

MLM Bacteriostatic Water Treatment Unit
(under-counter unit)

Installation

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Turn off the water going to the faucet. Disconnect the line to the faucet at the cold water cut-off valve. Attach the line from the cut-off to the bottom of the unit. Attach the line from the top of the unit to the line going to the cold side of the faucet. Turn the water on.

Let water run for fifteen minutes. Then resume normal use.

Backflushing

Turn off the water. Disconnect the lines at the unit. Connect the line that was on the top of the unit to the connection on the bottom and the line that was on the bottom connection to the connection on the top. Turn the water on. Let the water run through the unit for ten minutes. To reconnect the unit, turn the water off and reverse the lines back to their original location. Let the water run through the unit for two minutes.
