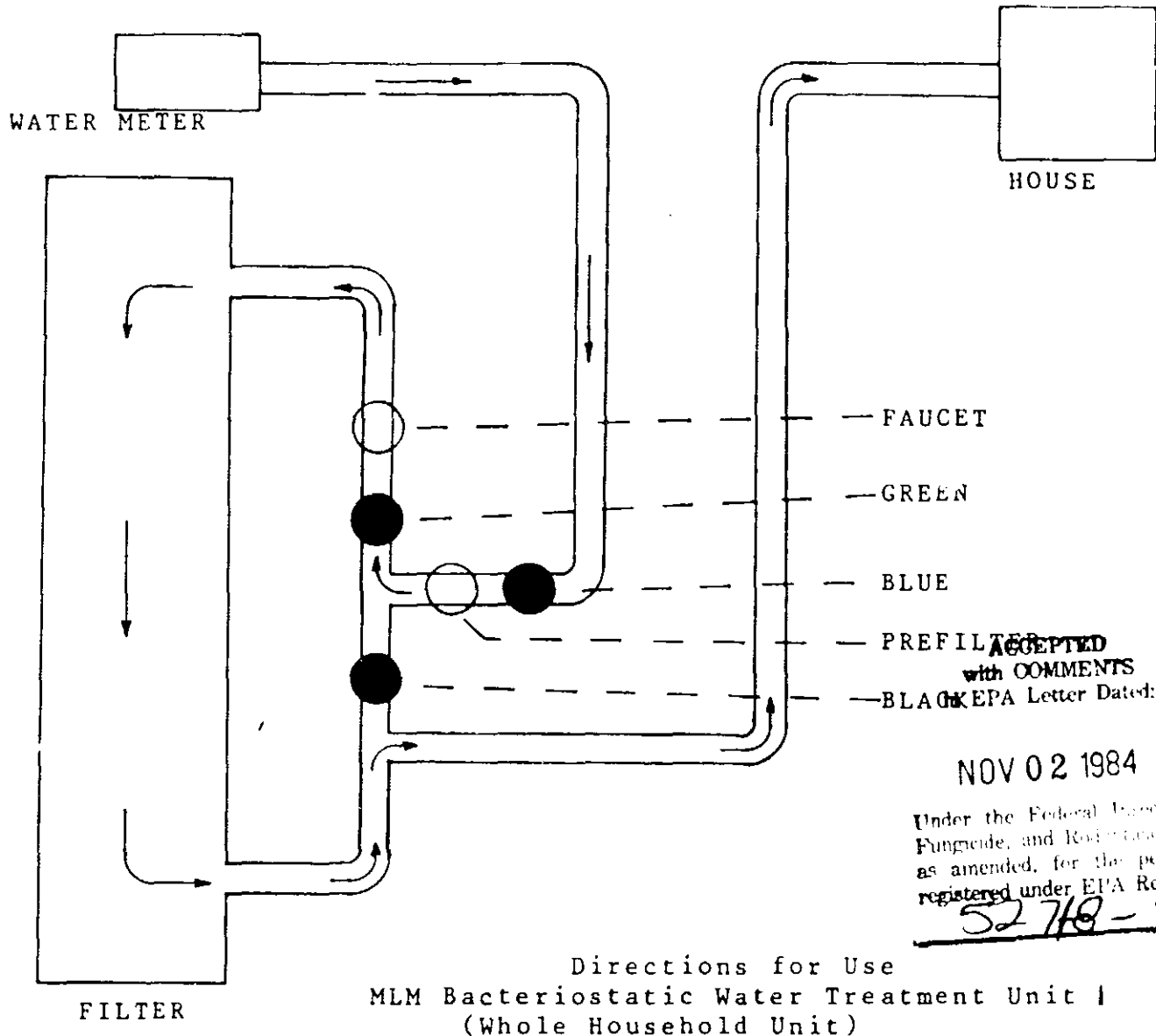

 MLM Bacteriostatic Water Treatment Unit I
 (Whole Household Unit)

INSTALLATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Turn off water at meter.
2. Remove 6 to 8 inches from existing water line at the desired point of installation for distribution throughout the household.
3. Connect the valve assembly to the water line as illustrated.
4. Attach water filter to valve assembly using the threaded fittings provided.
5. Backflush immediately. (see below)

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. For backflushing, first attach a garden hose to the faucet. The valves should be positioned as follows:

BLUE - OPEN
 BLACK - OPEN
 GREEN - CLOSED
 FAUCET - OPEN

2. Turn water on at meter and allow to run for 15 minutes.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)

3. To resume normal operation the valves should be positioned as follows:

- BLUE - OPEN
- BLACK - CLOSED
- GREEN - OPEN
- FAUCET - CLOSED

4. Open any faucet in the home and allow to run for 5 minutes, then resume normal use.

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
