Contact Spray: To kill cockreeches (waterbugs), fleas, earwigs, centipedes, sowbugs (pilibugs), boxelder bugs, ants, silverfish and crickets: Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets and other harborages. Hit as many insects directly as possible. Apply the apray to the point of run-aff. Repeat as necessary.
