

Aqua Cide N175 is used in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 3.3

Aqua Cide N175 per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 1.1

Aqua Cide N175 per 1000 gallons

every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not store five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas.
