GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

Aqua Cide N7 is used in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 8.68 Aqua Cide N7 per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is established. Subsequent slug additions of 2.8 Aqua Cide N7 per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage. STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Drums should be opened in well ventilated areas. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack or container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Do not mix with other pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate. Do not dispose of or use according to local, State, Federal, or Environmental Control Agency representative at your EPA Regional Office for disposal.
