

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and innumerable effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Aqua Polycat fluid ounces of Aqua Polycat per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Aqua Polycat per 10,000 gallons should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 5 to 8 fluid ounces of Aqua Polycat per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially Aqua Polycat per 1,000

gallons of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Aqua Polycat should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. Aqua Polycat is compared used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with alkaline pH. Aqua Polycat decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
