

DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Microbio-Clean #60 is used to control bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air wash systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 8 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 8 parts per million of Microbio-Clean #60 in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial slug additions of 0.2 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the sum of 3.33 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water.

Microbio-Clean #60 is used in air-washing systems that maintain effective misting to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 3.33 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Slug additions of 2.25 to 5.55 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed at the frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the sum of 3.33 fluid ounces of Microbio-Clean #60 per 1000 gallons of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand. Container closed when not in use.
