



Then have patient drink plenty of milk, gelatin solution, beaten egg whites, flour and water, or other nonoily demulcent. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

CMX-46

is used for recirculating cooling tower systems and industrial microbiological slime. Prior to the use of CMX-46, industrial and/or commercial recirculating cooling towers should be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Initial slug addition of 12.0 to 17.9 fl. oz. of CMX-46 per 1000 gal. of water to provide 100 to 150 ppm, based on total weight of water.
