On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 52991-6".
 - b. Submit an amended CSF (Guideline Number 62-2) based upon the preliminary analyses of five separate batches (Guideline Number 62-1) of a production size quantity, as opposed to a laboratory scale quantity. Any changes in manufacturing process from laboratory scale to production size must be reported. The upper and lower certified limits must be based upon the highest and lowest (respectively) analytical values obtained. Additionally, you must submit analytical methods and detectors used to determine active ingredients and impurities, along with related chromatograms and other relevant data (Guideline Number 62-3).


- c. Add intended use of the end-product, i.e., "to be used in formulation of end-use products which will be used as a behavior modifying pheromone for mating disruption of each twig borer (*Anarsia lineatella*) on fruit and nut trees" to Directions for Use on product label.
 - d. Add "Do not use from damaged, punctured, or unsealed containers" to Directions for Use.
 - e. Add the following to the beginning of Precautionary Statements: "May cause skin and eye irritation."
 - f. Since there are no intentionally added inerts in this formulation, you must change "Inert Ingredients" to "Inert Materials" in the ingredient statement and make it a part of the Active Ingredient statement.
3. Submit two copies of the revised label before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Conditional registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of a pesticide. If EPA determines, at any time, that additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under Section 3(c)(2)(B) of FIFRA.
