This product is intended to treat well water, cisterns, holding tanks or other water supplies by sanitizing until consumed. It is not intended to replace safe and properly constructed wells. EPA recommends for human consumption 2.8 free available chlorine residual to be determined by using a test kit provided by your B&B dealer. 1 gram normally treats 20 gallons of average well water. This product is available in a granular or pelleted form (pellet weight is 1 gram). The pelleted form can be used in the various types of pellet dispensers for continuous treatment of the water supply. Consult the owners manual for specific instructions on the desired setting.


**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
