It is a violation of federal law to use inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOLS

For a new pool or for spring start-up (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution per 10,000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.2
B) Add manually or by a feeder device sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6,000 gallons of water. This dosage will maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. The amount of chlorine and chlorine residual are in the product label.

NOTE: This product degrades with increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain 1.0 ppm available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood or leakage, absorb with sand or other inert material. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water. Do not reuse. Recycle, if available, or dispose of by placing in an approved land fill. Product or rinse water may be diluted with water and disposed of with household wastewater. Do not use for animal feed or feed by storage, disposal or incineration.

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
