DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law inconsistent with the labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For a new pool or for spring water (16 fl. oz. of 5.25% hypochlorite solution per 100 gallons of water. This dosage is by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.5.
B) Add quantity of 2.5% sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One ppm hypochlorite solution for 4.0 to 1.0 ppm average chlorine maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm at all times and number of swimmers and chlorine residual are 1.0 ppm.

NOTE: This product degrades in sunlight. Increase dosage, as necessary, if chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Avoid direct sunlight. In case of spill, rinse empty container with water. Rinse empty container to manufacturer or discard by an approved recycling method. Product diluted with water and disposed in that food or feed by storage.
