

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CL

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate (16 fluid ozs. of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine).

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6-7.8 range and maintain. **B)** Add manually or by a feeder device, sodium hypochlorite solution alternate to maintain an available chlorine of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 fluid ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will maintain 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of application and number of swimmers. Use test kit to maintain and chlorine residual are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit to increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area, away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection container or an approved land fill. Product or rinsate that cannot be recycled should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not use as a feed or food by storage, disposal or cleaning or other use.
