This filter provides good tasting water for filter for five years and still leaves 2,000 gallons for other uses.


This statement conflicts the above paragraph which states total gallonage of 10,000 gallons at 2000 gallons per year for 5 years.

q. Add the following statement:

This unit has a capacity of up to 10,000 gallons. It is capable of treating 5 gallons of cold tap water daily for a period of 5 years. Toward the end of the 5 years you will notice a diminishing water flow. This will indicate that the unit is nearing the end of its useful life.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

How to Install and Use Your Bacteriostatic Home Spring Water Filter

A. How to Install your water filter

- 1. Unpack contents:
 - a. Counter top water filter
 - b. Diverter valve assembly with plastic tubing
 - c. Universal adapter (This adapter fits 90% of kitchen faucets; additional adapters are available at any hardware store.)
- 2. Unscrew aerator from faucet. (Place a rubber washer on faucet, screw on adapter if needed), then screw on diverter valve.
- 3. Before drinking any water from the unit, turn on the cold tap then pushing button on diverter valve. Allow water to flow for approximately 30 minutes or 10 gallons. This water has purged carbon fines and entrapped air from the unit and should be disposed of.

B. How to use your water filter General Classification:

- 1. "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."
- 2. Once the Home Spring Bacteriostatic water filter has been installed, it will be maintenance free, with no filter replacement required.
- 3. The water filters have been tested by a licensed laboratory to last for 10,000 gallons of municipally treated water. Studies show that the average family of four will use approximately 2,000 gallons of water per year for drinking and cooking. This filter provides good tasting water for five years and still leave 2,000 gallons for other use.
- 4. Maximum water temperature: 85° F
 Maximum water pressure: 125 psi
 Maximum water flow: 1/3 gallon per minute

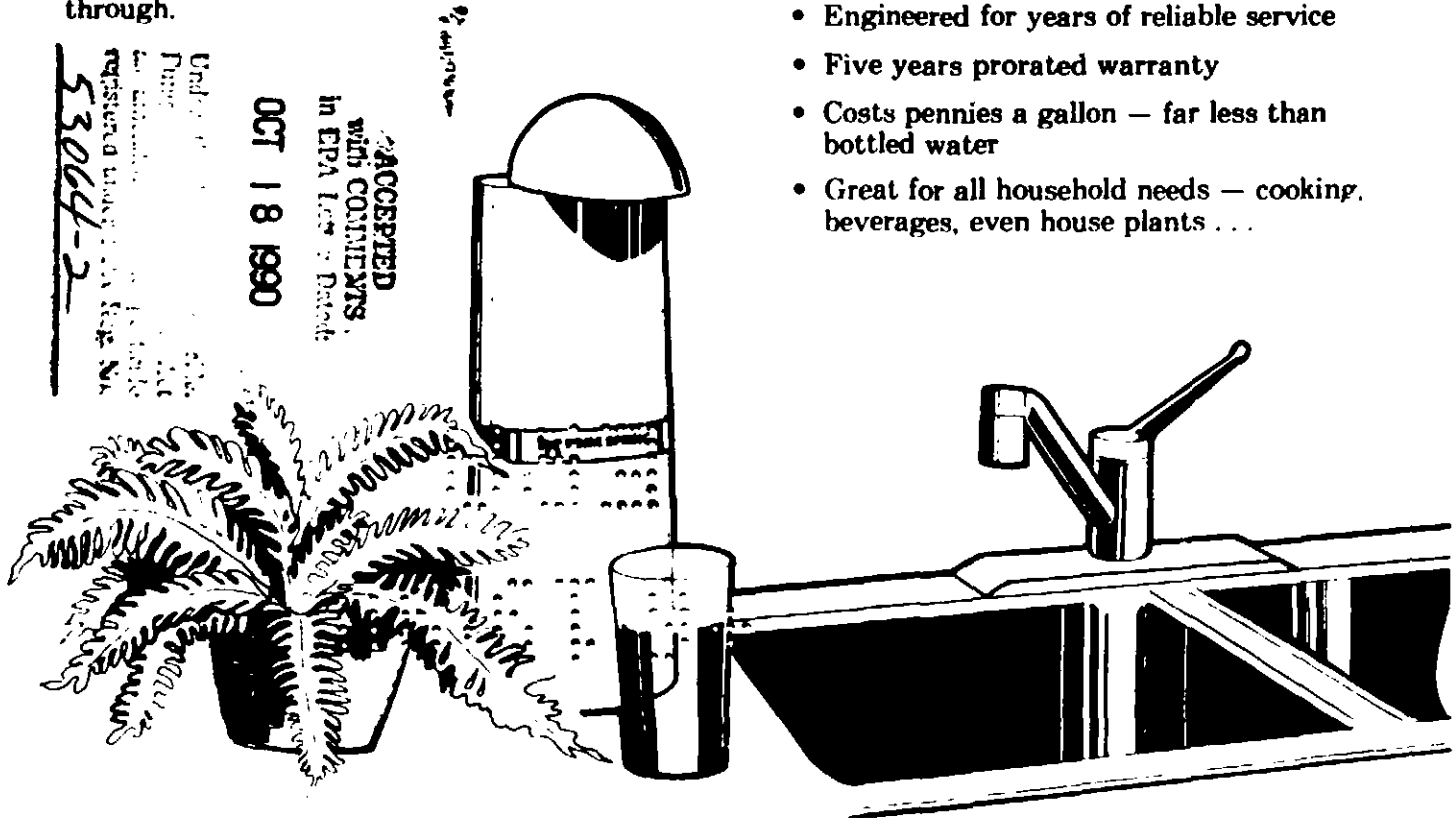

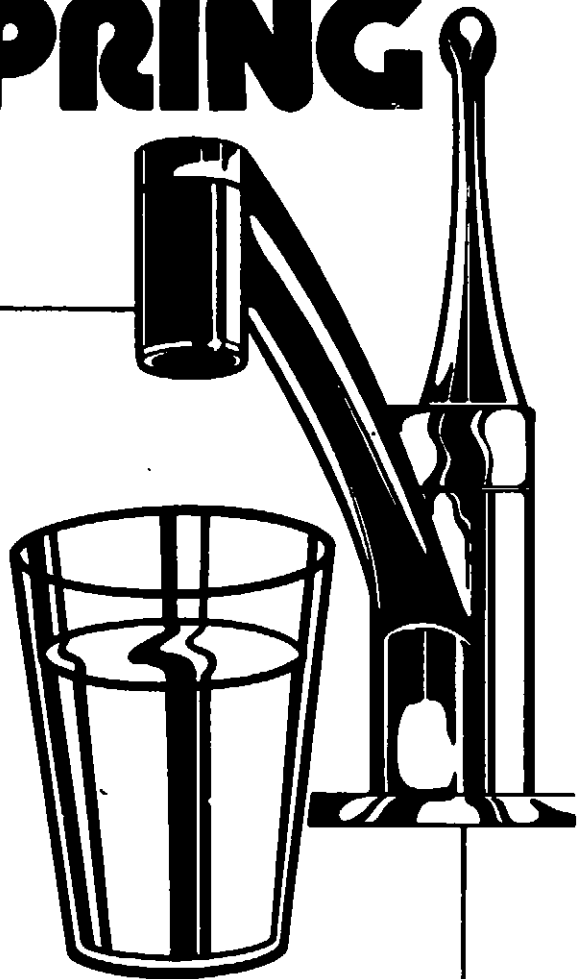

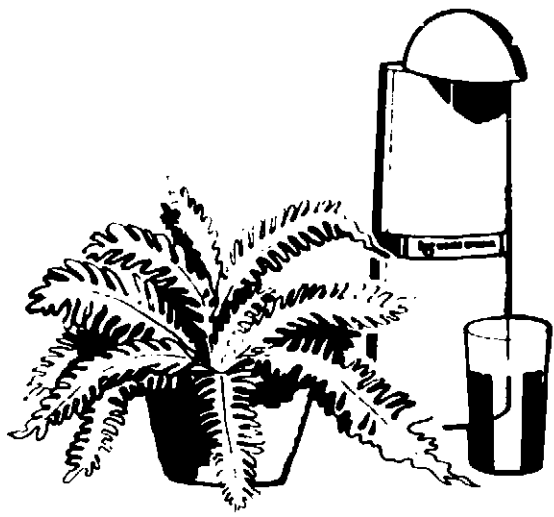
