INDOORS: TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS: Spray liberally in the evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally particularly under rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.
TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, GRASSHOPPERS, BEETLES, SILVERFISH, CENTIPEDES, AND MILLIPEDES: Spray in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, and harborages. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet.
TO KILL ANTS: Spray directly on insects, and around windbreaks.
TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use in all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS: Apply as a contact spray. Spray directly on insects. Avoid spraying plants or turf except to spray insects.
ANTS: Same as directed above for indoor use.
WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS, BEES: Same as directed above for indoor use. Contact as many insects as possible in nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, etc.
EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CRICKETS, BEETLES, SILVERFISH: Apply as a contact spray, as for indoor use.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS: Application should be made as soon as tents are first noticed. For best results apply in the late afternoon. Have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and repeat as necessary.
