

MB-9 is used to control bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air wash systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of MB-9 fluid ounces of MB-9 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 8 parts per million of MB-9 in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial slug additions of 0.2 per 1000 parts per million of MB-9 employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the supply lines of the air-washing systems that maintain effective maintenance to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 3.33 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed a frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem.
