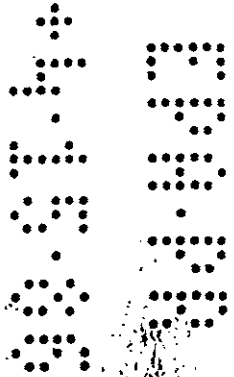

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: CAUTION- Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid contamination of feed or food stuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before space spraying. Cover all food handling surfaces. Cover or remove all food or cooking utensils. Do not use on edible crops. Do not remain in treated area until spray has dried or area has been ventilated.

Environmental Hazards: This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of waste. When used on boats, do not wash or flush freshly sprayed surfaces into adjacent water.

Physical and Chemical Hazards: Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junctions and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

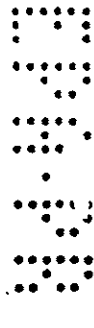
INDOORS

SPACE SPRAY: Before application - cover all food handling surfaces. Cover or remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover or remove aquariums and bird cages.

Flving Insects: To kill house flies, stable flies, gnats, mosquitoes and flving moths. Adjust sprav nozzle to deliver a fine mist spray. Close all doors and windows. Shut off air conditioners. Point nozzle upward and direct sp ay mist to all parts of the room, especially around windows and other light sources which attract insects. At all times, keep sprav nozzle at least four feet from fabrics or other surfaces that might be stained when wet with water. Fill the room with mist at the rate of 1 fluid ounce per 1,000 cubic feet. Then leave the area and keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes.

Ventilate area before reusing.

CONTACT and RESIDUAL SPRAY for CRAWLING INSECTS: To kill flies, cockroaches (water bugs), ants, crickets, silver fish, earwigs, centinedes, millepedes, sowbugs and adult and exposed stages of carpet beetles, confused flour beetles, and grain weevils. Adjust spray nozzle to deliver a coarse sprav. Keep nozzle 8 to 12 inches from all surfaces. Apply to contact as many insects as possible. Spray into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, under sinks and refrigerators, around baseboards and other harboring areas.



To Kill Spiders: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to webbing and cracks and crevices.

To kill ants: Spray doorways, around window frames, ant trails and hills.

Surface treatments will aid in the control of crawling insects for up to four weeks.

FLEA and TICK CONTROL: To kill fleas and brown dog ticks on dogs and cats, apply as a mist directly to animals along back, under forelegs and other areas except the scrotum and anus. Do not spray directly into eyes or mouth of animal. Part hair to assure skin contact and thorough coverage. Repeat application within 24 hours of first application if necessary. To reduce reinfestation, spray animal bedding and other resting areas until the surfaces are slightly moist. Spray entire inside areas of dog houses. Spray at a distance of 12 to 18 inches.

OUTDOORS

Pests Out of Doors: Do not treat or allow this spray to contact lawns, trees, flowers or shrubs because of possible plant injury.

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats (Midges), Deer Flies, Stable Flies, Flying Moths and Fruit Flies: When the air is still, spray resting areas to reduce the annoyance from these pests. Hold sprayer 18 to 24 inches from area to be treated.

Spray with a slow sweeping motion while moving away from treated area. Treat porches and patios in a similar manner. Allow spray to dissipate before reoccupying treated area.

Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Bees: Same directions for INDOORS. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Set spray nozzle to deliver a coarse wet spray or stream. Spray directly into nest openings and saturate nest. Hit as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

Spiders, Ants and Fleas: Same as INDOOR directions.

Fire Ants: To Kill and temporarily reduce annoyance of these insects, apply as a coarse spray to surfaces outside the house, such as windows, doors. Spray ant trails and mounds. Wet surfaces and directly hit as many insects as possible. This application will not kill the colonies, but it will reduce the immediate population for up to four hours. Repeat as necessary. See Plant Caution.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store this water-based formulation at temperatures below 32°F (0°C). Store in the closed, original container in a locked area away from children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
