

is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Portions of 4.8 to 11.9 fluid ounces of Algae-Treat per 1000 gallons of water should be employed. Frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leave drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or similar material. Container closed when not in use.
