DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent to tabeling. Read the entire label before using product.

IMPORTANT: SharpShooter is a general contact herbicide and will damage or destroy all vegetation which it contacts. Avoid overspray or spray drift onto desirable lawn grass, flowers, shrubs or trees. Keep people and pets off treated areas until dry to avoid product transfer to desirable vegetation. Herbicidal action is rapid with effects visible within hours. For most rapid kill, apply in warm, dry weather. May cause white coloring on some types of brickwork or concrete. Color will wear off after a few weeks.

SHAKE CONCENTRATE WELL and dilute as indicated below for spot treatment of weeds.

Rates: Young annual weeds (3–5 leaves) – Mix 1 part concentrate with 5 parts water (about 5 ½ oz. per quart).
