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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For small or large pools dilute, scatter over surface or feed through a chemical feeder 3-5 ozs. of Chlorine to each 1,000 gallons of water. Repeat treatment DAILY OR AS NEEDED to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm as determined by frequent testing with a chlorine test kit. Also a pH range of 7.2 to 7.6 should be maintained. Both chlorine content and pH will vary due to temperature and number of swimmers and should be checked daily. Degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or rinsing that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
