

BLE WATER RINSE.

ALL SURFACES TO BE TREATED SHOULD BE THOROUGHLY CLEANED BEFORE USING BON-CHEM BON-SAN 353 SANITIZING SOLUTIONS. FOR ALL SANITIZING APPLICATIONS USE 1 OUNCE BON-SAN 353 TO 3 GALLONS OF WATER.
