

DIRECTION FOR USE

DAIRY AND FOOD PLANTS

Tank trucks, holding tanks, silos, vats and plant equipment. Sanitize pre-cleaned equipment with PENNSAN CIP-DF (1 ounce/5 gallons of water). Drain PENNSAN CIP-DF solution from equipment thoroughly and do not follow by a water rinse.

CIP LINES - Closed System: Flush entire system with tepid water until water runs clear, then sanitize with PENNSAN CIP-DF (1 ounce/5 gallons of water) by circulating solution through lines. Drain sanitizing solution from the system thoroughly. Do not rinse.

BEVERAGE PLANTS

Pre-Mix and Post-Mix Vending Machines, Plant Equipment: Sanitize pre-cleaned surfaces with PENNSAN CIP-DF solution (1 ounce/5 gallons of water). Drain sanitizing solution from the system thoroughly and do not follow by a water rinse.

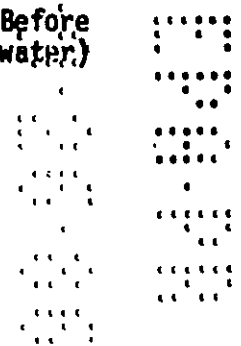
DAIRY FARMS

Bulk Milk Cooling Tanks. Before filling the tank with milk, sanitize clean tank with PENNSAN CIP-DF (1 ounce/5 gallons of water) by brush, circulation or spray method. Drain sanitizing solution from tank thoroughly and do not follow by a water rinse.

Farm Dairy Utensils: Before milking, sanitize clean utensils with PENNSAN CIP-DF solution (1 ounce/5 gallons of water) by rinse or spray.

Inflations: Brush inflations after milking with warm (110-120°F) PENNSAN CIP-DF solution (1 ounce/gallon of water) using good inflation brush. Rinse thoroughly and store as directed by sanitarians or field men. Before milking, sanitize with PENNSAN CIP-DF solution (1 ounce/5 gallons of water) and drain thoroughly.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Acid-Based Concentrate. CORROSIVE TO TISSUES. CAUSES EYE DAMAGE AND SKIN IRRITATION. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray or fogging mist.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Prior to use of this product, remove gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment from all surfaces, then wash with detergent or other cleaning solutions followed by a thorough potable water rinse.

To prepare a sanitizing solution, add one fluid ounce of PENNSAN CIP-DF to 5 gallons of water which will provide 200 ppm of anionic surfactant as determined by the use of Pennsan XXX Test Kit according to its instructions. (Modified for PENNSAN CIP-DF.) Allow 2 minutes for exposure time. Following use in a mechanical system, used solutions cannot be reused. For manual operations, fresh sanitizing solutions should be prepared daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool place. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

PLASTIC CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Product or rinsate that cannot be used should be diluted with water, neutralized with sodium carbonate and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
