Skintex MRIII-2008B Manufacturing Concentrate is designed to be used with two binding agents, Cognis 3001-A and Cognis 3002-A, along with water. The typical amount of each component in the mixture is 6% Skintex MRIII-2008B, 8% Cognis 3001-A, and 0.3% Cognis 3002-A, with water as the remainder. The specific amount of water used will vary depending on the specific application of the textile mill. Please refer to the Technical Data Sheets provided with the Cognis 3001-A and 3002-A binding agents for exact amounts of products to be utilized when treating individual fabric/appare Manual Community of Manu
