The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

The Agency has reviewed your product chemistry data and found it acceptable.

The efficacy data (MRID no. 415260-01) are more than adequate to support a claim of "aids in the control of fire ants" when the subject product is injected into fire ant mounds according to label directions. It is the Agency's opinion that "aids in control" is too conservative since it underpromises the ability of the subject product to kill and reduce populations of fire ants. We recommend the claim be upgraded to "controls...." In this case "control" is a reduction to a level at which additional treatment will not usually be necessary under the conditions described on the label. Your product certainly meets this qualification.
