

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. If in eyes, flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets away from heat, open flame or other sources of heat or ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

FOR FIRE ANT MOUNDS: (A) Install delivery tube on spray can. (B) Begin spraying, then insert delivery tube in ant mound while maintaining spray delivery. Insert in several locations to maximum possible depth within the mound while maintaining spray delivery. (C) Remove delivery tube, re-install spray nozzle and spray mound surface thoroughly. **NOTE:** For best results, apply in cool weather or in early morning or late afternoon. Treat new mounds as they appear.

FOR FORAGING ANT CONTROL: Using the spray nozzle, spray ants directly.

FOR WASP AND HORNET CONTROL: (A) Spray from an up wind position. (B) For best results, spray nest from a distance of 8-12 feet, when possible (8-12 feet is the optimum spraying

distance). (C) Aim nozzle at nest and spray to thoroughly cover nest. Also directly spray emerging wasps or hornets. (E) Apply to nesting areas at dusk when possible, since most of the insects have returned to the nest and are less active.

FOR YELLOW JACKET AND BEE CONTROL: (A) Directly spray in a sweeping motion on external flying insects around the opening of the nest. (B) Move forward to the nest opening and spray directly into the nest hole. (C) Apply to nesting areas at dusk when possible, since most of the insects have returned to the nest and are less active.

INDOORS: Within residential buildings including homes and apartments and within nonfood areas of industrial, institutional and commercial buildings including hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants and warehouses. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage areas (after canning or bottling). Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants. **FOR CONTROL OF COCKROACHES, ANTS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS:**—Spray into cracks and crevices in walls, dark corners of rooms, cabinets and closets, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, around plumbing and other utility installations, around waste containers, and wherever these insects hide or are found. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

OUTDOORS: SPIDERS, ANTS, CRICKETS:—Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects congregate. Repeat as necessary. For ANTS, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as reinfestations occur.
