STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If product gets in eyes, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. In case of skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If product is swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

ESCO-S10

ESCO-S10 is used in commercial and industrial recirculating cooling water and potable water supply systems. It should not be used in preparation. Before treatment with ESCO-S10 begun, cooling water systems should be cleaned of deposits. Then they should be drained, refilled with water. Add a dose of 2.5 to 10.0 fluid ounces of ESCO-S10 per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat until 0.5 to 10.0 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons needed. To control the growth of bacteria in industrial cooling water, add 0.5 to 5.0 fluid ounces of ESCO-S10 per 1000 gallons of water entering the system, continuously.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not stack more than five drums high. Do not store in areas. Leaking or damaged drums should be placed in overpacks and disposed of in a secondary container. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Do not discharge into waterways. Pesticide spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If you are unable to use a pesticide product according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at your EPA Region. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent).
