#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Strong oxidizing agent, avoid contaminating combustible materials such as clothing, wood, or leather as a serious fire hazard will result. Contact with strong acids may cause evolution of poisonous and possibly explosive mixtures of chlorine dioxide and chlorine gases. Decomposes above 500°F.

- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**Storage:** Avoid exposure to high temperatures during storage. Store remote from other chemicals and combustible materials. Do not skid or slide drums.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

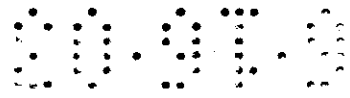
