On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. The EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of the subject product.

b. As per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section must be revised to read:

"CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin or on clothing. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material."

c. Per the acute toxicity review, the following User Safety Recommendations must be added to the label:

User should wash hands before, eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

User should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."

d. In the Directions for Use, revise the label to replace "pepper" with "chili pepper" and "green beans" with "dry beans". It should be noted that "beans" are listed twice in the directions for use. The duplicate text must be deleted from the label.

e. Place the statement "This pesticide is toxic to fish" to fall directly below the "Environmental Hazards" heading.



FIRST AID

If on Skin or Clothing:

- Take off contaminated clothing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For manufacturing use only in the formulation of defoliant and herbicide end-use products containing a fire suppressant to be used on the following crops: cotton, sunflowers, rice, safflower, pepper, sudangrass, sorghum, corn, beans, green beans, peas, wheat, peppers and potatoes. Do not use this product to produce formulations intended for residential use (including recreational uses).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage:

Avoid exposure to high temperatures during storage. Store remote from other chemicals and combustible materials. Do not skid or slide drums.

Pesticide Disposal:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal:

[Refillable Containers:] Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times. Offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

[Non-refillable Containers:] Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling or reconditioning, if available. Triple-rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. If recycling is not available, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

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
