DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in air-washing systems, 1544 should be added to the water. For use in recirculating commercial and industrial air-washing systems, 1544 to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 1544 fluid ounces of 1544 of water to provide a concentration of 24 per 1000 gallons of water.

In the system, is recommended. Repeat initial slug additions of 0.73 per 1000 gallons of water.

60 parts per million of 1544 should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the form of 1544 is used in air-washing systems that maintain effective concentrations of 1544 to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the form of collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leakproof drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or similar material and disposed of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
