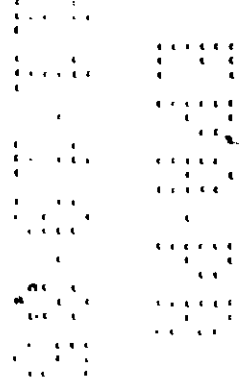

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TREATING WOOD

This extra strength Wood Preservative is especially formulated for treating wood in above grade applications. It is not a sealer, stain or varnish. Touraine Clear Wood Preservative will not chip, crack, blister or peel. Adds years of protection to wood and when overcoated, greatly extends the life and beauty of the paint system. Clear Wood Preservative protects wood against warping and rotting. It will not stop or prevent the natural discoloring of woods due to exposure to sunlight. The Preservative contains a strong fungicide for excellent protection. The extra strength protection is important where wood comes in contact with soil, concrete and water. Use Touraine Green Wood Preservative for below grade applications. Clear Wood Preservative is recommended for use on shingles, millwork, window sills, furniture, docks, piers, fences, rough sawed lumber, doors.

Surface Preparation:

Wood should be clean and dry, well seasoned and free of bark. Mildew must be removed from all surfaces, utilizing a solution of 50% household bleach and 50% water. Areas affected by mildew should be thoroughly scrubbed with this solution, then hosed down with clean water and allowed to dry. Rubber gloves and goggles should be used for personal protection during this process.

Application:

Stir thoroughly. Clear Wood Preservative can be liberally applied by brush, roller, spray or dipping in a container. The more wood preservative absorbed the more effective the protection. Do not thin. Material is supplied at proper application consistency. A single coat is recommended for surfaces to be painted or stained and may be painted after 24 hours with oil, solvent or latex based paint. Be sure to remove all bark. Where no finish is to be used, apply a second coat within one hour.

Coverage:

Up to 300 square feet per gallon, depending on porosity of wood and method of application.

Clean-up:

Clean painting tools immediately after use with paint thinner or mineral spirits.
