DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply more than 150 g of active ingredient per acre per year.

Method of Application: For use in almond, walnut, pistachio, pecan, hazelnut, fig, pomegranate, apple, pear, orange, grapefruit, lemon, carob, date, peach, apricot, plum, loquat and other crops where navel orangeworm is a pest.

Deploy **ISOMATE Mist NOW** in the spring as soon as the tree canopy is fully leafed Activate **ISOMATE Mist NOW** by firmly pressing onto can, keeping away from face. Activation is confirmed by an audible "CLICK" when emitter is secured onto the can and one cycle of the spray mechanism occurs within 3 seconds. The emitter is preprogrammed to activate over a maximum of 12 hours per day (5 PM-5 AM).

Product Placement: Hang activated **ISOMATE Mist NOW** unit in the center of the tree canopy with the nozzle pointing downwind and at least three (3) feet from fruits or nuts. Distribute the units in a grid pattern considering topography, prevailing wind direction and historical pest pressure to achieve a rate of one unit per acre.

For optimal results, **ISOMATE MIST NOW** is best used apply prior to pest emergence and in large contiguous areas. Minimum suggested acreage size is 40 acres.

Mode of Action and Management: ISOMATE Mist NOW suppresses mating of navel orangeworm. Immigration of mated female moths from adjacent external sources of infestation will reduce the level of control. Manage by one or more of the following: a) Treatment of external sources of infestation with **ISOMATE Mist NOW**; b) Treatment of external sources of infestation with an effective insecticide; c) Treatment of the pheromone treated orchard with an effective insecticide.

Areawide application is the most effective use of **ISOMATE Mist NOW**. Supplementary applications of insecticide are advised in conjunction with **ISOMATE Mist NOW** until pest populations have been reduced significantly. All pests must be monitored so that timely intervention with effective insecticides is possible.
