  - b. Replace the environmental statement with the following:



**PERIODIC DOSE:** For continued microbial control, add 1 gallon Algicide 10-01 to the sump pan for each 4000 gallons of water in the system every 7 days or oftener should be needed.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICE**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. For eye irritation, remove and wash contaminated clothing.
