



# ACCO TRIPHENE™

*Disinfectant Cleaner & Deodorant*

**Staphylocidal • Pseudomonacidal • Tuberculocidal • Fungicidal\***

A triple phenolic cleaner-disinfectant-deodorant with broad spectrum kill. For Hospital and Nursing Home use. Virucidal on environmental hard surfaces against Influenza A<sub>2</sub>. Cleans, disinfects and deodorizes in one application at ½ oz. per gallon. (1:256). Dilutes clear in water up to 400 ppm hardness, leaves no film or scum, does not mar or lift floor finishes. Has no effect on conductivity of conductive floors. Phenol coefficient vs. *S. aureus*, 20; vs. *S. typhosa*, 22 (AOAC Method).

## ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Ortho-phenylphenol .....	11.0%
Ortho-benzyl-para-chlorophenol .....	6.0%
Isopropanol .....	5.0%
Para-tertiary-amylphenol .....	4.0%
Trisodium N-hydroxyethylenediaminetriacetate .....	0.6%
Essential oils .....	0.3%

INERT INGREDIENTS ..... 73.1%

\* Fungicidal to pathogenic fungi on environmental surfaces.

## DIRECTIONS

Dilute as directed. Do not mix with other cleaners.

To clean, disinfect and deodorize nonporous surfaces: Use ½ oz. per gallon on floors, walls, kitchen and lab equipment, bathroom fixtures, showers, lavatories, garbage and refuse cans. For porous surfaces (cement block, scoured furniture) or grossly contaminated surfaces, use 1 oz. per gallon with special attention to thorough cleaning. Potable water rinse required when disinfecting hard surface food contact items. **Fogging:** For unoccupied rooms as an adjunct to regular cleaning/disinfecting routines, use 1 ½ oz. per gallon per average room. Allow 2 hours minimum after fogging before entering room. Do not use in presence of humans, animals or plants.
