The amended labeling submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, for the above-named product is acceptable provided that you make the following revision before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Delete item #3 under "General Use" (i.e., "To disinfect fabrics such as sheets, linens, aprons, and uniforms: First rinse to remove gross filth or heavy soil, then soak for 10 minutes, in a solution containing 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene"). As indicated in our previous letter, efficacy data are required to support this claim.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of this condition.

A stamped edited copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

A soapless, synthetic detergent with broad spectrum kill of micro-organisms both gram positive and negative. Non-harmable and non-volatile in use dilutions. For use on electrically conductive floors. Excellent solubility, dilutes clear (1:256) in hot, cold or hard water of up to 400 ppm water hardness. Contains biodegradable detergent. Dilute as directed using standard measuring cup or jug pump. Do not mix with other cleaners. Rinse empty Acco Triphene container thoroughly with water and discard it.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Household Use

1. To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls and other non-porous surfaces, use 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water. Apply with a cloth, sponge, mop, or mechanical spray device, making sure all surfaces are wetted thoroughly. Allow surfaces to remain wet for ten minutes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

2. To log an un-occupied room as an adjunct either preceding or following repair, cleaning and disinfecting procedures, use dilution of 1:24 or 1 1/2 ounces of Acco Triphene per gallon of water per average size room. Allow minimum of 2 hours after logging has stopped before entering room.

3. *Virucidal activity: 1/2 ounce per gallon disinfects influenza A₂ (Asian Flu) carried on inanimate environmental surfaces.

General Use

1. To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, tables, drinking fountains, sinks, refrigerators, stoves, restroom fixtures, telephone booths, bird cages, kennels and garbage cans. Remove gross film and heavy soil with a preliminary cleaning step prior to application of Acco Triphene. Apply a solution of 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water with a cloth, sponge, mop, or mechanical spray device, making sure all surfaces are wetted thoroughly. Allow surface to remain wet for ten minutes.

2. To clean and disinfect such articles as combs, brushes, razors, scissors, instruments and rubber goods. Wash articles clean and soak for ten minutes in a solution containing 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water.

3. To disinfect surface areas of floors, walls, ceilings, and window sills, use 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water. Allow surface to remain wet for ten minutes. In a solution containing 1/2 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water.

4. To clean gross film or heavy soil prior to disinfection, use 1 ounce of Acco Triphene per gallon of water.

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.
