DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING IN SEWERS TO CONTROL COCKROACHES: Apply liberally to sewer using dusting application equipment.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants and other food handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, trailers, bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT: Apply liberally to exposed food or feed in held, processed, prepared or served areas. FOOD AREA-APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT: receiving, storage, packing, (canning, bottling, wrapping, storage and enclosed processing systems such as mills, dairies, etc.) anywhere food or feed is stored, processed, prepared or served.
