### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in Homes, ~~Warehouses~~, and Non-Food Areas of Kennels, Commercial  
Buildings, Warehouses, Theatres, Office Buildings, Schools, Motels, and Hotels.

### TO KILL FLEAS (ADULT, PRE-ADULT, AND LARVAE) AND TICKS:

Spray should be applied uniformly, using a sweeping motion to carpets, rugs,  
draperies, upholstered furniture, etc. Spray until slightly wet, allow to dry  
one hour and vacuum dead insects. Repeat as necessary. Spray sleeping  
quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, and door frames, wall cracks,  
and local areas of floors. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters  
after spray has dried. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Animals should be  
treated with a registered product to kill fleas and ticks before reentering  
area.

### TO KILL ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, CARPET

BETTER, SOWBUGS, WATERBUGS: Spray on carpet and on floors along  
baseboards, directly into cracks, crevices, and all places suspected of  
harborage. Contact as many insects as possible with spray.  
(To Kill Carpet Beetles and Dermestids): Spray along baseboards, edges of  
carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving,  
and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.
