Also, as per our letter dated September 22, 1987, a 1-year storage stability study on this product must be submitted by December 22, 1988. This study must be conducted at ambient temperature with analyses at the start of the study, periodically during the year of storage and at the end of 1 year.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

DRY FORMULA

TO KILL FLEAS, MOSQUITOS, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS AND WASPS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.
