

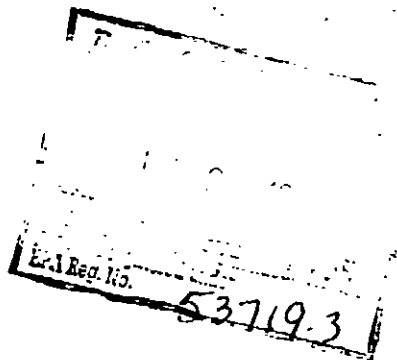

DRY FORMULA

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS AND WASPS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.
