Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

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g. To the Storage and Disposal statement, add "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal." Also add "Do not puncture or incinerate container."

- a. On the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and on the Data Matrix, please provide the flashpoint of the product with the propellant and the flame extension.
