For use in households, schools, warehouses, office buildings, theaters, garages, hotels, motels and kennels.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Spray on floors along base-boards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc. TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion 3 feet from surfaces. Spray 10 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.
