DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When used as directed, SANI-KING ADJUST-A-CHLOR for spas and hot tubs is effective as a spa and hot tub water sanitizer and disinfectant. To maintain sparkling clean and odor free water, let SANI-KING ADJUST-A-CHL float freely in the spa or hot tub.

Under normal use conditions, use one ADJUST-A-CHLOR per 350 gallons of water. Under heavy bather load or reduced water circulation, additional dispensers may be used to maintain constant active chlorine residuals of 2 to 4 ppm. To increase the chlorine residual, turn the rotating cap to a higher number located in the flow indicator window. To decrease residual, turn to a lower number.

To a freshly filled spa or hot tub, begin with the ADJUST-A-CHLOR indicator setting on #5. Check the chlorine residual frequently. When 2 to 4 ppm chlorine residual is obtained, lower the flow indicator setting to #1 or #2 to maintain constant recommended chlorine residuals. The pump and filter should be operated for at least three hours per day. Do not heat water above 104 F. Keep the spa free of leaves and debris. Residential spas and hot tubs should be drained, cleaned and refilled with fresh water every 60 days. Heavy use will require more frequent draining. Keep pH between 7.2 and 7.6 and never allow it to fall below 7.0. Total alkalinity should be maintained between 100 to 150 ppm and calcium hardness between 150 and 300 ppm at all times.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store product in original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not contaminate food or feed with this product. This product is designed for one time use. When empty, rinse in spa water, drain, and dispose of properly.

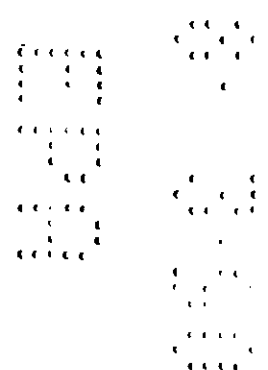
