PLACEMENT: Turn circulation pump off, turn dial to Pac Removal, open drain valve on side of Cyclor and remove cap from Cyclor. Remove cap from New Water Pool Protector without removing the seal and insert container upside down into the center of the Mineral Reservoir pushing down gently to puncture seal. Replace the cap and drain valve on the Cyclor. Turn control dial on the Cyclor to maximum and turn pump on for 90 minutes allowing New Water Pool Protector to circulate through the pool.

REMOVAL: Turn pump off, turn dial to Pac Removal and Remove Cyclor cap.
