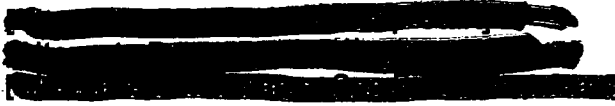

Product Description: This product perfectly accompanies the Spa Frog Floating System or In-Line System by starting up a freshly filled spa with an initial chlorine level. The effervescent action helps the chlorine dissolve faster and the fizz tells you its working! For best results use Spa Shock after balancing the water and before using your Spa Frog System.

Directions for Use: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Residential Use. To a freshly filled spa or hot tub add one packet for up to 500 gallons of spa water. After the product has bubbled for a few seconds turn on the high speed jets for one minute {or} until fully dissolved. Maintain a pH of between 7.2 and 7.8. Test water with a pH Test Strip to see if desired level has been reached.

{For periodic shocking, particularly during time of heavy use, add one packet per 500 gallons when the water looks cloudy or as a maintenance dose every week. After the product has bubbled for a few seconds turn on the high speed jets for one minute {or} until fully dissolved.}

Test water with a chlorine Test Strip to see if desired level has been reached. Reentry is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm chlorine due to risk of bodily injury.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Product Storage: Keep this product dry in a tightly sealed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding.
