Bin Preparation: As with other acids, P-7 is corrosive. Recommended usage listed below.

- f. Delete "Place P-7 Nozzle in a closed conveyer system or storage tank". This statement is confusing and contradicts later directions for use.

- g. Delete "Do not breathe P-7 fumes". The appropriate statements are in the Precautionary Statements section.

3. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PREPARATION: PLACE P-7 NOZZLE IN A CLOSED CONVEYOR SYSTEM OR STORAGE TANK. DO NOT BREATHE P-7 FUMES AS WITH OTHER BLENDING OF ACIDS. P-7 IS CORROSIVE. RECOMMENDED USAGE LISTED.

APPLICATION: P-7 is suggested for application directed below immediately after harvest to prevent fungal growth in stored corn, milo, barley, wheat, oats, rice, peanuts, soybeans and cotton seed.

APPLY UNIFORMED, by use of low pressure spray nozzle achieving uniform coverage as grain passes through applicator. Stop grain flow immediately in event of spray failure or nozzle plugging. Concentrations of untreated grain may develop fungal growth which may spread and spoil all grain in the bin. Clean bins, silos, store room thoroughly before storing grains. Increasing the suggested rate of application in the table by 25% for the top 10% of the grain placed in each storage bin will provide additional protection against the effect of normal moisture migration in the grain during storage. These rates protect stored corn, sorghum, wheat, oats or barley up to 12 months.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.  
**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or dilute is a violation of Federal Law.
