

For use [only (when packaged exclusively for outdoor use)] outdoors in yards, patios, picnic areas, campsites, drive-ins, around swimming pools, and poultry houses.

For use indoors and outside premises of hotels, motels, homes, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, seed houses, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk handling areas of milk plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, boats, ship cabins and hospitals.
