The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10 for the above referenced product. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "NOTIFICATION" and placed in our records.

### The alternate brand names **BURGESS INSECTICIDE FORMULA 3** and **BURGESS READY-TO-USE INSECTICIDE FORMULA 3** have been added to the product record.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) and is subject to review by the Agency. #### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. This product is an effective formulation that kills crawling insects fast. It stays on treated surfaces and provides residual insect killing power for up to three months.

#### GENERAL:

- Use product to control Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks on contact. Apply to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages, grasses, and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found.
- Avoid soaking young or flowering plants.
- To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.
- Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).
- For crack-and-crevice treatments, treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.
- All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:
  - 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
  - 2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (*e.g.*, soil, mulch, or lawn);
  - 3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
  - 4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
  - 5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (*e.g.*, driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
  - 6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.
- For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.
- Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes.
- Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.
- Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.
- Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

#### Flies and Mosquitoes:

For outdoor use only as an aid in controlling these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures, on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate.

Ants, Ticks (including ticks which may transmit Lyme disease), Crickets, Fleas, and Earwigs: For treatment of infestation of these insects in areas where there are weeds or bushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. When treating for Ticks, give special attention to areas frequented by pets. For Ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways.

#### **Building Perimeter Treatment:**

To help prevent infestations of buildings by Ants, Crickets, Spiders, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs), treat a 12 -18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, and their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

#### PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

#### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL AND CONTAINER HANDLING:
